She graduated from the Victorian College of the Arts Music Theatre course in 2008. Since then, she has performed and written for theatre and television.

She debuted her one woman show *FOMO: The Fear of Missing Out* at the Melbourne Fringe Festival in 2013, and was a recipient of the Adelaide Fringe Festival Tour Ready Award. This led to sell-out seasons in Adelaide and Melbourne International Comedy Festival. Zoe debuted internationally at the Edinburgh Fringe Festival in 2014, with the Huffington Post UK naming Zoe as one of the "Four female comedians to watch at the Edinburgh Fringe 2014." In 2016 Zoe returned to the Melbourne International Comedy Festival
